
¹⁵The Lord God took the man and put him in the garden of Eden to till it and keep it.

GriefShare provides help and encouragement after the death of a spouse, child, family member, or friend. Sessions will be led by St. John members in a warm, caring environment. **Grief Share will run every**Tuesday for 13 weeks. There is no cost to attend.
