# Russ Leeper:

One of the great things about being a pastor is getting to interact with the little kids. Whether it's during the children's sermon, Vacation Bible School, or just greeting them at the door, it's always a surprise what they'll do. Some days they're quiet and scared. Other days they'll speak to me so quickly and excitedly about their Sunday School class or stuffed animal that I just can't figure out what they're saying. And still other days they'll walk up to me with a very serious look on their face, shake my hand with their own little hand and say, "Good morning, Pastor," just the way they've watched their parents do it week after week.

A mother once told me that as her family was eating dinner one night, their three-year-old son suddenly looked up from his spaghetti and announced, "Pastor Russ makes his own shoes!" Now, I have never made my own shoes, nor have I ever claimed to make my own shoes. When his parents quizzed him as to why he thought that I made my own shoes, he was unable to explain. Maybe he had dreamed it. Maybe he had imagined it. Or maybe he just made it up for a joke. Either way, I took it as high praise that he had welcomed me in to become part of his inner life and thinking. And I was amazed that I would be so much a part of his life even though he had only ever interacted with me in the children's sermons and at the church door.

We have a greater effect on the people around us than we realize ... especially the children. We have a wonderful group of kids here at St. John. They're crazy and loud sometimes, quiet, and shy other times, and on occasion, deep and thoughtful ... just as children should be. And as members of their church, you're part of their lives. You may mean more to them than you think. So, make sure you take the time to talk to them, play with them, or just give a friendly smile. Who knows ... they might even make up a story about you. Wouldn't that be nice?
