Amazon Primed

Now, I want to begin this story by telling you that, whenever possible, I prefer to shop locally. But sometimes there are things that I can't get locally, so I order them online from Amazon Prime. This was the case a few weeks ago when I wanted to give out small, wooden crosses to the kids at the end of the children's sermon. I ordered them online and, with my Amazon Prime free, two-day shipping, they were supposed to arrive by Thursday ... in plenty of time for the Sunday service. But then, on Wednesday, I got a notification from Amazon telling me that the delivery date had been changed from Thursday to Sunday! That wasn't going to work at all.

So, I got back online and found some different wooden crosses that would arrive in two days ... on Friday. Crisis averted. Since I didn't need the first order of crosses, I went online to cancel the order and get my \$8.11 back. But when I did, I found out that I couldn't cancel the order, I couldn't return it after it came, and I couldn't get my money back. I was annoyed! I was indignant that I was being forced to pay \$8.11 for 50 crosses that I didn't need, anymore, because THEY changed the delivery date!

I tried to email my displeasure, but the email came back undeliverable. So, I hunted and hunted and finally found a customer service number on Amazon's website. I was ready to give someone a piece of my mind. I had the phone in my hand and was about to dial the number when a voice in my head said, "Do you really want to be that guy? Do you really want to be the guy who gets angry at a stranger over \$8.11 worth of crosses? Do you REALLY want to be the guy WHO WORKS AT A CHURCH and can't possibly find a use for 50 extra crosses?" I took a deep breath, calmly put down the phone, and told myself, "It's fine. You'll use them for something else. There's no reason to be crabby at someone about it."

I recently went on a long road trip across the country and couldn't help but notice that there a LOT of Amazon Prime trucks on the road these days. And in the course of the trip, I saw at least a half dozen of those Amazon Prime trucks broken down along the side of the road. And every time I saw one, I thought, "Well, they're not getting their free, two-day delivery, either." And I realized that not getting my crosses on time wasn't personal ... it was just the result of someone having a bad day. It made me feel more compassionate toward all the people who get us our stuff on time and all the people who have to deal with us when we don't.

In this Easter season, we celebrate that Christ is risen (He is risen, indeed)! We celebrate that, through his death and resurrection, sin, death, and the devil have been defeated. We're no longer enslaved by our selfishness. We're set free to love others. We have hundreds of opportunities every day to exercise that freedom! How will YOU turn from selfishness and love others? As for me, I'm making an Easter resolution to not let Amazon get me primed for anger, frustration, and lashing out.



Mobile food pantry needs your help

Delivery of food from the Northeast Iowa mobile food pantry by the St John bus is off to a wonderful start! This is a greatly needed service in our community because there are many people that qualify for food from the pantry but have mobility or transportation limitations and are unable to come to the fairgrounds to pick it up. Unfortunately, the St John bus is at its capacity and cannot fit anymore deliveries. There are many people on the waiting list. We are in need of people that can deliver food with their personal vehicles. The mobile food pantry is held the first Wednesday of the month at the Floyd county fairgrounds. Delivery vehicles will be loaded up at 6:00 pm. Deliveries are limited to within a 5 mile radius of Charles City. If you are interested in helping, call Jen Burton the mobile food pantry coordinator at 641-220-1769. Depending on the size of your vehicle, 2-4 households worth of food will likely fit in in a personal vehicle. Even if you are not able to deliver every month, we still can use your help. You do not need to be a St John member to help, anyone can help. Thank you for your support of this ministry!

Our registration began on Monday, January 29, for our families who were *currently* enrolled. Registration for *new* families was held at our first ever Registration Open House on Thursday, February 8. We had a great turn out at that event and continue to get registrations! Registration will continue until all our classes are full. Families who have a child who will be at least 3 on or before September 15 can register for our morning class. That 3-day class meets Monday-Wednesday-Friday mornings from 8:30-11:30 a.m. Families who have a child who will be at least 4 on or before September 15 can register for our two afternoon classes. The 4-day session meets Tuesday through Friday from 12:30-3:30 p.m. (Statewide Voluntary Preschool Program and is FREE) and the 5-day session meets EVERY day from 12:30-3:30 p.m. A \$30 non-refundable registration fee is due at the time of registration. Our Generosity for 4th Quarter 2023

Your offerings to St. John were shared beyond our walls in the 4th Quarter in the Following ways: 8% of our regular offering \$9,328.23 went to support the mission of the larger church.

2% of our total offering goes to support our community needs. The October recipient was CC Cares in the amount of \$906.90 for the community Christmas meal, the November recipient was Messiah Food Bank in the amount of \$899.75 and the December recipient was Coats for Kids in the amount of \$1,229.69. Those checks were dispersed to be used for this mission within our church community.

The 8% Thank Offering was shared with the Northeast Iowa Food Bank program through our church by purchasing personal care items for gift bags to each recipient. We delivered 200 bags throughout the community. The products were purchased for a total of \$1,716.83 and the balance of the quarter total was divided up \$600.00 to City of Charles City for a bench in the new playground, \$250.00 to the Blessing Box and \$250.00 to the Messiah Food Pantry.
