Blue Christmas

One of my vivid childhood memories from this time of year is of being sprawled out on the living room floor, looking at our illuminated Christmas tree, and listening to our humongous RCA console stereo playing the Elvis Presley Christmas album:

I'll have a blue Christmas without you

I'll be so blue just thinking about you

Decorations in red on a green Christmas tree

Won't mean a thing, dear, if you're not here with me

As a kid, I don't think I really understood those words. I had never experienced the kind of loss that Elvis was singing about ... the kind of loss that makes what's supposed to be the happiest time of the year into one of the saddest times of the year.

Now, at age 57, I hear those words so differently. Rather than just an innocent, childhood memory, I think about all the people I know who will be struggling with the Christmas blues this year because someone they love is gone. You might be one of those people. If you're having a blue Christmas, my heart goes out to you. Know that you're not alone. Even though being sad at Christmas time can feel so isolating, I can assure you that there are many others around you who are going through the same thing.

That's why this year Intern Beth, my wife Susan, and I are putting together a *Blue Christmas Service*. This is a Christian tradition that happens on December 21st, the longest night of the year, and is about comforting those who are grieving and struggling to find joy and hope during the Christmas season. It's a safe space for us to gather together in God's presence, being honest about the reality of grief and the fact that healing takes time. It will be a quiet and contemplative service with candles and no expectations. You can sing or not sing ... cry or not cry ... participate or just listen ... it's up to you and whatever you need. Either way, you will be in the company of people who care about you and the God who loves you ... no matter how you feel.

Our St. John Blue Christmas Service will be Thursday, December 21 at 5:30 PM. Everyone is welcome.

Whatever you're going through this Advent and Christmas season, I pray that God's peace, which surpasses our understanding, will accompany you on your journey and give you light, even in your darkest nights.

Statistical Report on Consecration Sunday Results

A total of ___93 __ giving units (husbands and wives or single persons) completed *Estimate of Giving Cards* this year.

A total of <u>68</u> of these giving units increased their financial commitment above their last year's amount.

A total of <u>93</u> giving units present to fill out *Estimate of Giving Cards* today committed a total of <u>\$251,337.92</u>.

Based on last year's giving records, we can expect to receive \$\frac{\$232,352.85}{} during the coming year from people who have consistent giving patterns during the past twelve months but are not present today.

Based on the average total of loose offerings during the past three years, we can expect to receive \$ 4779.15 during the coming year from that source.

Church income from non-donor sources such as interest, rentals and fees: \$ 1697.89 .

This gives us a grand total of **\$ 498,031.79** anticipated income for the next year.

The total income for our general operating budget during the last twelve months was \$.470,600.19.

Next year, we can expect our operating budget income to increase by \$26,044.66.

Delivery of food from the Northeast Iowa mobile food pantry by the St John bus is off to a wonderful start! This is a greatly needed service in our community because there are many people that qualify for food from the pantry but have mobility or transportation limitations and are unable to come to the fairgrounds to pick it up. Unfortunately, the St John bus is at its capacity and cannot fit anymore deliveries. There are many people on the waiting list. We are in need of people that can deliver food with their personal vehicles. The mobile food pantry is held the first Wednesday of the month at the Floyd county fairgrounds. Delivery vehicles will be loaded up at 6:00 pm. Deliveries are limited to within a 5 mile radius of Charles City. If you are interested in helping, call Jen Burton the mobile food pantry coordinator at 641-220-1769. Depending on the size of your vehicle, 2-4 households worth of food will likely fit in in a personal vehicle. Even if you are not able to deliver every month, we still can use your help.
