While serving at a previous congregation, I walked into the office one day and the treasurer handed me a letter. It was a letter from an organization with whom we regularly did business. The treasurer had a funny look on her face and it worried me. I took the letter with some hesitancy, afraid that it was going to be bad news... overdue account, collection notice, or something like that. But as I read the letter, I saw that it was just a standard annual fee notice.

"This looks o.k." I said, "What did you want me to see?"

"Look at the salutation," she said.

Then I saw it. This organization had sent a bill to the church that began: "Dear God". The treasurer and I had a good laugh about it and wondered if the person who typed in "God" was serious, joking, or sarcastic. The whole thing was just too much for our Ministries Coordinator. She just had to get to the bottom of things. So, she contacted the supervisor whose name and number were on the letter and began telling him that a mistake had been made and that the letter had been sent to the wrong person at the church. Before she had a chance to finish explaining the situation to him, the supervisor told her that a mistake had <u>not</u> been made and that if it was sent to the wrong person it was our fault... we must have given them the wrong name.

She replied, "Well, God is here, but he doesn't pay our bills."

There was a long silence on the supervisor's end of the phone with lots of nervous keyboard typing in the background. Finally, the supervisor said that he'd look into it and get back to us. We never heard back from him.

God is with us here at St. John, too, and provides us with all the resources we need for the ministry we're called to do. But God doesn't pay our bills. It takes human hands like yours and mine to write the checks and set up the electronic giving. God provides by working through us.

Despite living in times that are financially challenging, we are so grateful for the faithful gifts we have received in 2022. Your hands are God's hands every time you write a check, click on electronic giving, or put money in the offering plate. God is taking those offerings and turning them into God's Love in Action!
