Dear Congregation,

"The Lord bless you and keep you; the Lord make his face to shine upon you and be gracious to you; the Lord lift up his countenance upon you and give you peace."

Numbers 6:24-26

Martin Luther believed that the priestly benediction found in Numbers was the very blessing that Jesus gave the disciples as He was ascending into heaven because Luke specifically mentions that Jesus lifted his hands when He was blessing them. The priestly benediction is a blessing of continual promise that God communicates to Moses to instruct Aaron and his sons to be repeated to each individual as a community. God declares that God's name will be put upon the people in this way. I share this blessing with you as we enter the new year as a reminder that God's action of blessing is not bound by time. God's action takes place in the big moments of our lives when everything feels so exciting, in the quiet seemingly mundane moments where everything feels repetitive, and in all those liminal spaces in between. Whatever moment you are in, this blessing is with you. God's love is in action in your life for the name of the Almighty is upon you.

Seminary has been an exciting time for me and I am excited to be travelling to the Nordic lands for Wartburg Seminary's J-term coursework. As part of this immersive experience I will learn about different aspects of the Nordic church and culture while spending time with Icelandic, Faroese, and Norwegian clergy in their day-to-day ministry. We will also be in conversation with faculty and students at the University of Iceland in Reykjavik and at Menighetsfakultet in Oslo. I am focusing my studies on the role that the Lutheran church plays in the lives of those within these communities and the differences/similarities between cultural conditioned assumptions about life and church. I look forward to being able to share all I see and learn with you.

But wait... there's more. As I near endorsement in my candidacy process my time of discernment focuses on the rostered leadership that I am best suited for and my readiness to complete candidacy. This means that I must officially declare my intended roster. After careful consideration and (many) conversations I have declared Word & Sacrament, so I am officially working towards becoming a pastor. This means that I will not formally graduate until Spring of 2026 (though I should finish up classes at the end of January 2026). I am thankful to journey with St John throughout this process as I continue to learn and grow into my vocational call.

Unfortunately, the St John bus is at its capacity and cannot fit anymore deliveries. There are many people on the waiting list. We are in need of people that can deliver food with their personal vehicles. The mobile food pantry is held the first Wednesday of the month at the Floyd county fairgrounds. Delivery vehicles will be loaded up at 6:00 pm. Deliveries are limited to within a 5 mile radius of Charles City. If you are interested in helping, call Jen Burton the mobile food pantry coordinator at 641-220-1769. Depending on the size of your vehicle, 2-4 households worth of food will likely fit in in a personal vehicle. Even if you are not able to deliver every month, we still can use your help. You do not need to be a St John member to help, anyone can help. Thank you for your support of this ministry!
