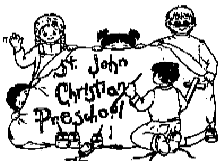
### **Sunday School News**

Our little friends were certainly busy during the month of February. We learned all about the letters O, H, Q, & N - how to write them on our own, the sounds each letter makes, and how to sign each letter in American Sign Language. Our 5-day friends are continuing to learn more sight words and are already showing great beginning skills for reading!

February was also a very exciting month for our preschoolers as each class was able to host its own Valentine's Day Tea Party. Every small friend was allowed to invite one tall friend to our class for cold cocoa, hot cider and some yummy treats. We ended our day reading Valentines in the laps of our tall friends. We have loved having the privilege of getting to know our many friends and their amazing families this school year, but it is already time to start thinking about registration for the fall semester and welcoming some new families to our preschool program. Please feel free to pass on the following information to anyone who may be interested:

Our registration began on Monday, January 30, for our families who are *currently* enrolled. Registration for *new* families began on Monday, February 6, and will continue until all of our classes are full. Families who have a child who will be at least 3 on or before September 15 can register for our morning class. That 3-day class meets Monday-Wednesday-Friday mornings from 8:30-11:30 a.m. Families who have a child who will be at least 4 on or before September 15 can register for one of our two afternoon classes. The 4-day session meets Tuesday through Friday from 12:30-3:30 p.m. (Statewide Voluntary Preschool Program and is FREE) and the 5-day session meets EVERY day from 12:30-3:30 p.m. A \$30 non-refundable registration fee is due at the time of registration. Families may choose to pay \$50 for the entire year or \$30 per semester. Please call Whittney Franke for any further information: 228-7274.
