So, my family joined our neighbors in celebrating this beautiful way to share joy and care. We now have our own memories to share of this day and have experienced the gifts of giving.

The call to generosity goes beyond any holiday. I encounter similar gifts in my regular giving, such as when donating groceries and other items to the blessing box. For me, this is a whole process and spiritual practice. As I take care to shop for healthy, filling, and convenient meals or snacks and look for ways to use my cashback, coupons, and rewards for everyday useful items my heart and attention is directed outwards. I pray in my actions that our neighbor experiencing hunger and food insecurity has their basic need met for daily bread, and that this lifts their spirit. 
Please take a moment to reflect on how St. John and this synod are making a difference together through a spirit of generosity, love of God and love for our neighbor:


The class will meet in the chapel on Sundays from 10:15 to 11:00AM.

Mobile food pantry needs your help

Delivery of food from the Northeast Iowa mobile food pantry by the St John bus is off to a wonderful start! This is a greatly needed service in our community because there are many people that qualify for food from the pantry but have mobility or transportation limitations and are unable to come to the fairgrounds to pick it up. Unfortunately, the St John bus is at its capacity and cannot fit anymore deliveries. There are many people on the waiting list. We are in need of people that can deliver food with their personal vehicles. The mobile food pantry is held the first Wednesday of the month at the Floyd county fairgrounds. Delivery vehicles will be loaded up at 6:00 pm. Deliveries are limited to within a 5 mile radius of Charles City. If you are interested in helping, call Jen Burton the mobile food pantry coordinator at 641-220-1769. Depending on the size of your vehicle, 2-4 households worth of food will likely fit in in a personal vehicle. Even if you are not able to deliver every month, we still can use your help. You do not need to be a St John member to help, anyone can help. Thank you for your support of this ministry!

Update on the Bell


Roger Michael says he was told it was from the previous church. It would be nice if we got information or confirmation from anyone else in the know, but Roger is a good source.

We discovered that the old bell does have a clapper inside and it has 1892 stamped into its metal stand. A church history book references that there was a rebuilding and enlargement of the old church that was completed in 1893, more evidence that it is probably from the old church.

Our interest in this is historical and related to the upcoming 100th anniversary of our current church. It has been suggested to have it cleaned and fixed up a bit to put on display outside our church in honor of that anniversary since it would have been rung for the last time 100 years ago.
