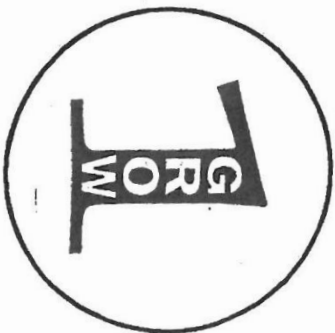
# A REVEALING BREAKDOWN OF OUR CONGREGATION'S GIVING PATTERNS
